

ANTI-BRIBERY AND CORRUPTION POLICY

Western Blueprint Limited is committed to applying the highest standards of ethical conduct and integrity in its business activities. Every employee and individual acting on our behalf is responsible for conducting company business honestly and professionally.

Western Blueprint Limited does not tolerate any form of bribery by, or of, its employees or any persons or companies acting for it or on its behalf. The Board and senior management are committed to implementing and enforcing effective systems to prevent, monitor and eliminate bribery, in accordance with the Bribery Act 2010.

A bribe is a financial advantage or other reward that is offered to, given to, or received by an individual or company (whether directly or indirectly) to induce or influence that individual or company to perform public or corporate functions or duties improperly.

Employees and others acting for or on behalf of Western Blueprint Limited are strictly prohibited from making, soliciting or receiving any bribes or unauthorised payments.

Employees and other individuals acting for Western Blueprint Limited should note that bribery is a criminal offence that may result in up to 10 years' imprisonment and/or an unlimited fine for the individual and an unlimited fine for Western Blueprint Limited.

Western Blueprint Limited will not conduct business with service providers, agents or representatives that do not support our anti-bribery objectives.

All employees and others acting for, or on behalf of, Western Blueprint Limited are encouraged to report any suspicious activity to the Directors, who will support any individuals who make such a report in good faith.
